Please complete a range of the following homework tasks by Friday 6th July. Each completed task will earn a number of housepoints. Tasks can be completed in any order and can be handed in on any day when they have been completed.

RE

Choose your favourite quote from the bible (as taught in school) and create a painting that represents your understanding of the quote.

(Up to 5 housepoints)

News

Write a newspaper report about the day after the D-Day landings.

(Up to 5 housepoints)

English

Write the final chapter of your own Jeremy Strong story.

(Up to 3 house points)

Music

Create your own musical instrument with household equipment. When you have made your instrument play along with your favourite song.

Maths

Create your own maths game suitable for year 5 children.

(Up to 3 house points)

Topic – Can you feel the force? Was Hitler a good leader?
How can we rediscover the wonders of Ancient Egypt?

Create a model of a famous place in 'Ancient Egypt', this could be the pyramids, the lighthouse at Alexandria or Abu Simbel

(Up to 10 house points)

Create a fact file about a famous Egyptian pharaoh.

(Up to 5 house points)

Use the internet or books to research Ancient Egyptian weapons. Using this information you will need to make a replica of the weapon using papier-mâché. You will need to then complete a small information text to inform people what the weapon was used for. (Up to 10 house points)

Experiment with a range of materials that would be suitable for a parachute to slow an object down. After doing this create your own parachute (no larger than 1m²) that will slow down a ball of paper.

(Up to 3 housepoints)

Create an information text about the life of Anne Frank. Why is this young girl so renowned today?
