Homework Schedule summer term 2015

Please complete **5** of the following homework tasks by Friday July 10<sup>th</sup>. Each completed task will earn a number of house points. Tasks can be completed in any order and can be handed in on any day when they have been completed. Children are responsible for providing their own paper and other materials but don't forget to ask for help if you are unsure about a particular task.

Topic title: Would the Beatles have won X Factor?

The Beatles come from Liverpool.  
Can you find out 3 facts about Liverpool?  
up to 3 house points

Make up your own band!  
Pick 5 people who are well known for making music. Put them together in a band and give the band a name. Draw a poster to show Year 1 your band. Don't forget to label the people in your band.  
up to 3 house points

Pretend to be Simon Cowell.  
Listen to a piece of music or a song that you've not heard before. Review the song or piece of music, say what you liked or didn't like about it. Are they through to the next round?  
Don't forget to say what the music was that you picked.  
up to 3 house points

Choose a band or solo singer.  
Find out 5 facts about them, you can include pictures to go along with your facts.  
up to 3 house points

Be a musical instrument designer!  
Can you design and make a musical instrument?  
You can bring it into school and show the class how it makes a sound.  
up to 3 house points

Topic title: Which birds and plants would Little Red Riding Hood find in Hollins Vale?

Find out the names of 5 different trees. Either take a photo or draw the trees and label them.  
up to 3 house points

Make a leaf collage. You could do leaf prints with paint or leaf rubbings with crayons if you like. **Remember to check with a grown up before you pick any leaves.**  
up to 3 house points

Go on a short walk with your grown ups. Record the different plants and trees you see on your walk. **Remember to check with a grown up before you touch or pick any plants.**  
up to 3 house points

Be a bird watcher!  
Spend some time watching through a window and record any birds that visit your garden. You could draw or list the birds that you see.  
up to 3 house points

Can you make a bird to go in the tree in our reading area? You could use collage materials to make it and it will need cutting out so that it can join the other birds in the tree. Try and make your bird look realistic.
