 <p><b>How to Make a Rainforest Terrarium with Kids</b></p> <p><b>Make a rainforest terrarium</b> <i>By placing a lid on your terrarium, it becomes a self-sustaining environment, and you and your children get a first-hand look at the water cycle.</i></p> <p><b>Build a Rainforest Terrarium in a Jar</b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b></p> <p>Large Jar, tank or bottle with lid</p>	<p><b>Where are Rainforests?</b></p> <p>Create a global map showing the location of different rainforests, add labels of named rainforests.</p> <p>Add labelled photos of different rainforests with a brief description</p>	<p><b>Save the Rainforest</b></p> <p>Create a poster campaign to encourage people to stop destroying the rainforest.</p> 

<p>Pebbles Activated Carbon/Charcoal or Moss</p> <p>Potting soil 1-3 small tropical plants (my favourite is the Palm, but any mini tropical plant works great)</p> <p><b>Layer your DIY Rainforest Terrarium:</b> Add 1 inch of pebbles to the bottom of the planter. Add a single layer of activated carbon. This will filter the water and help with clarity. Add a layer of moss</p> <p><b>Plant your rainforest:</b> Add a little bit of potting soil Plant small tropical plants.</p> <p>Add fresh moss to the top of the soil. Decorate with a few rainforest creatures</p>
